**JUDGMENT OF DISSOLUTION OF MARRIAGE (No Minor Children)**

This matter is before this Court on Plaintiff's Petition for Dissolution of Marriage. The Plaintiff is present in person, pro se.

Testimony heard. Agreement of the parties spread of record. Based upon the testimony heard this Court FINDS as follows:

1. This Court has jurisdiction, the Plaintiff having resided in Illinois for more than 90 days preceding the date of this Order. The Plaintiff resides in Sangamon County.

8. Irreconcilable differences have caused the irretrievable breakdown of the marriage, without cause or provocation by either party. The parties have attempted to reconcile those differences, without success, and future attempts to reconcile those differences would not be in the best interests of the family unit. The parties have executed a waiver of the two year period of separation.

The Defendant has been guilty of extreme and repeated acts of mental cruelty, without cause or provocation on the part of the Plaintiff.

The court therefore ORDERS as follows:

A. The marriage of the Plaintiff and Defendant is dissolved.

**B. Distribution of Property**

1. The Plaintiff is awarded the following marital property:

- a. Any personal property in the Plaintiff's possession and control.
- b. Any bank accounts, checking accounts, savings accounts, currently exclusively in the Plaintiff's name.

6. Each party shall destroy all joint credit cards and all credit cards in their respective possession that are in the name of the other party and shall refrain from any conduct that may tend to create liability to third persons in the other after the entry of this Judgment.

**B.** Each party is denied maintenance.
