HOW TO PROTECT EXEMPT

If you think your property may be exempt, you should contact an attorney. A lawyer can advise you of your rights. If you do not claim your exemptions, the money will be turned over to the creditor.

If the front of the Notice is a Citation to Discover Assets, the court date specified on the front of the page is the date set for you to tell the Judge if you have an exemption.

If you wish to have a court hearing on your exemptions you must notify the Clerk of the Circuit Court, Sangamon County Courthouse, Springfield, IL. not later than seven (7) business days from the date you were served with this Notice. Your request may be mailed but must be received not later than seven (7) business days from the date the Notice was served. Service is defined as the date this Notice was mailed. Your employer may be withholding under a Wage Deduction Order and you then may request a hearing in writing at the Clerk of the Circuit Court at any time before your Employer is required to turn over your wages. To get a court hearing, you need to submit a written request with the Clerk of the Circuit Court. If you choose a hearing, a hearing will be held within fourteen (14) days of your request.
