- 2 Each party shall be responsible for the payment of one half of any deductible and one half of any medical (including prescription drugs). dental, orthodontia, ophthalmological, psychiatric or psychological expense for the minor children not covered by insurance.
- 3. All reimbursements, one party to the other for medical expenses for the minor children, shall be paid within thirty days of the date the party paying the expense tenders to the other party proof of payment.
